Notice of First Public Meeting Nelson WWTP Complex Infiltration/Inflow Pilot Rehabilitation Project

Dear Property Owner:

Johnson County Wastewater (JCW) invites you to participate in the first of three public meetings to discuss sanitary sewer improvements in your neighborhood (the area in Shawnee bound approximately by 49th Terrace on the North, Johnson Drive on the South, Burton Lane on the East, and Long Street on the West). The public meeting will be held on **Monday, October 11, at 7:00 pm, at Shawnee Mission Northwest High School in the Cafeteria, 12701 West 67th Street** (see map on back).

If you cannot attend this meeting, a similar meeting will be held on Thursday, October 14, at 7:00 pm at the Prairie Baptist Church, 7416 Roe Avenue.

Representatives of JCW and their consultants will be present at these meetings to discuss different facets of the project. Residents will also have the opportunity to meet the project team, ask questions, and learn more about this project which will:

- rehabilitate existing public sanitary sewers,
- rehabilitate private sanitary service lines,
- remove selected private surface runoff and groundwater connections to the sanitary sewers (*which may require work to be performed in your home or business*), and
- provide critical information for future JCW system-wide sewer improvements.

The proposed schedule and anticipated topics for the upcoming public meetings are as follows:

- **October 2010**
Pilot project purpose, study findings, rehabilitation methods, and project schedule
- **Mid-January 2011**
Work locations, construction methods and processes, and updated project schedule
- **Early March 2011**
Construction schedule and construction-related impacts
