Notice of Third Public Meeting Nelson WWTP Complex Infiltration/Inflow Pilot Rehabilitation Project

Dear Property Owner:

Johnson County Wastewater (JCW) invites you to participate in the third public meeting to discuss sanitary sewer improvements in your neighborhood (the area in Shawnee bound approximately by 49th Terrace on the North, Johnson Drive on the South, Barton Lane on the East, and Long Street on the West). The public meeting will be held on **Wednesday, September 28, at 6:00 pm beginning with a one hour open house forum followed by a 30 to 45 minute presentation at 7:00 pm, at Shawnee Town Museum in the Town Hall Building, 11600 Johnson Drive** (see map on back).

If you cannot attend this meeting, a similar meeting will be held on Thursday, September 29, at 6:00 pm at the Prairie Baptist Church, 7416 Roe Avenue.

The Johnson County Board of County Commissioners recently approved funding for this construction project and selected Wiedenmann & Godfrey Construction, Inc. to perform the construction work through a competitive bid process. Representatives of JCW, our consultants, and Wiedenmann & Godfrey Construction, Inc. will be present at the meeting to discuss the project. **Residents will have the opportunity to meet the project team, ask questions, and learn about the construction phase of this project, including the neighborhood impacts, restoration, and anticipated construction schedule.**

The public meeting will begin with an open house forum for informal individual discussion with the project team followed by a formal presentation. This is the final public meeting focusing on the construction phase of this project which has begun.
