



## 2012 Johnson County Wastewater Rates

JCW customers will notice a change in our 2012 billing statement. Due to increased costs associated with transporting and treating wastewater, JCW rates have increased as well. The Bimonthly Average Winter Water Usage (AWWU) for residential customers which reflects water consumption for the winter of 2010/2011 has been recalculated. The following information details rates for each type of JCW customer:
